Privacy Policy

Stroud and District Film Society is subject to data protection regulations under UK law which control the use of personal data. In compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (May 2018), the Society will:

- Comply with the data protection laws of the UK
- Only collect personal data for the administration of the Society and its activities – this is limited to name, address, email address and phone number.
- Only contact an individual by post, email or telephone if they have given their explicit permission for that method and will be used to send you details of our programme, news, occasional flyers and publications.
- An individual can withdraw permission at any time by contacting the Society.
- Look after the data [it is strictly confidential] and not lose it.
- Allow an individual to see the data held about them and the Society will correct it and, if necessary or if requested, the Society will delete the data.
- Review the data held regularly and, when no longer needed for active use, the Society will either delete the data or, if a record is still needed [and the individual has not requested their record to be deleted], reduce the data held to the minimum necessary.
- Not use the data for business purposes.
- Not pass on the data to a third party without explicit consent to do so.
- Destroy data carefully so that it cannot be accessed in future.
